- 2 Kings 24:1-4 In his [Jehoiakim King of Judah] days Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon [Globalists] came up, and Jehoiakim became his vassal for three years. Then he [Jehoiakim] turned and rebelled against him [the elite deep state]. And the Lord sent against him raiding bands of Chaldeans [House Democrats], bands of Syrians [Senate democrats], bands of Moabites [Democratic Mayors], and bands of the people of Ammon [Antifa]; He sent them against Judah to destroy it, according to the word of the Lord which He had spoken by His servants the prophets [Jeremiah, Isaiah, etc]. Surely at the commandment of the Lord this came upon Judah, to remove them from His sight because of the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he had done, and also because of the innocent blood that he had shed; for he had filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, which the Lord would not pardon.
- 1 John 3:11 For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should love one another, 12 not as Cain who was of the wicked one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his works were evil and his brother's righteous. 13 Do not marvel, my brethren, if the world hates you. 14 We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death.
- 1 John 3:15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. 16 By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.
 - Phil 2:3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.
- 1 John 3:17 But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother <u>in need</u>, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?
 - James 2:14 What does it profit, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can faith save him? 15 If a brother or sister is **naked and destitute of daily food**, 16 and one of you says to them, "Depart in peace, be warmed and filled," but you do not give them the things which are needed for the body, what does it profit? 17 Thus also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.
 - 2 Thess 3:10 For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat. 11 For we hear that there are some who walk among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies.
- 1 John 3:18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth. 19 And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him. 20 For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.
 - 1 John 2:28 And now, little children, abide in Him, <u>that when He appears</u>, <u>we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming</u>.
- 1 John 3:21 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God. 22 And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are

pleasing in His sight. 23 And this is His commandment: that we should <u>believe on the name of His Son</u> <u>Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment</u>. 24 Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

- Test 7 Do you have faith in the biblical, historic Jesus or are you always questioning the God/Man aspect of who Jesus is?
- Test 8 Do you know the truth or do you easily fall for lies about a different Jesus?
- Test 9 Do you have confidence of eternal life when Jesus comes or when you die?
- Test 10 Are you considered a spiritual misfit to the world?
- Test 11 Do you practice righteousness?
