

# DOES EVIL EXIST?

Isaiah 45:6-7 says:

In the King James Version, verse 7 reads: *I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, **and create evil**: I the LORD do all these things.*

God is love and brings peace to all who seek and know Him through the Messiah, Jesus. But if we ask Him to leave our lives, schools, country and world, then hatred, calamity and evil will take its place; not because God “created” it, but because of our demand on Him to leave us.
