

# Letter From Pastor Kevin To Senators For Washington State Pertaining To David Ogden Confirmation Hearings For Attorney General Post

Dear Honorable Senator Cantwell/Murray,

I am writing to request that you vote AGAINST the confirmation of David W. Ogden for the number two spot for A.G.

I served 8.5 years in the Nuclear Navy with three of those years on a Submarine out of Pearl Harbor. I also spent another 14 years working with the military at Puget Sound Naval Shipyard. President Clinton's don't ask, don't tell policy was a masterful solution to the raging debate of the day and has served us well since then to prevent the widespread unrest that will result if open homosexuality is forced upon the military services.

Mr. Ogden's agenda to compel military personnel into accepting open homosexuality in the submarines and foxholes of the battlefield WILL DESTROY THE FIGHTING EDGE OF OUR MILITARY.
