

Why Mormons Say They're Christians

An author who grew up in the Mormon Church says she isn't surprised that a recent survey of Latter-day Saints (LDS) shows that they overwhelmingly consider themselves to be Christians.

The survey, "[Mormons in America: Certain in Their Beliefs, Uncertain of Their Place in Society](#)," was conducted by The Pew Forum on Religion & Public Life. It shows that 97 percent of Mormons consider themselves Christians. But an earlier Pew survey of the general public found that only 51 percent of Americans agree.

While the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, as it is officially called, comprises less than two percent of the U.S. population, it has been in the spotlight because it is the religion of GOP frontrunner [Mitt Romney](#).
