## PASTOR GETS PRISON FOR SERMON

Sentenced to month in jail for offending homosexuals

Note from Pastor Kevin: Coming to a country near you. Are you willing to be a witness even though you will be arrested? Do you love the truth more than your own life? Are you willing to do for the Lord Jesus what the founding fathers of this country did for the birth of America when they said, "And for the support of this Declaration [of independence], with a firm reliance on the protection of divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our Lives, our Fortunes and our sacred Honor?" A Swedish court has sentenced Ake Green, a pastor belonging to the Pentecostal movement, to a month in prison, under a law against incitement, after he was found guilty of having offended homosexuals in a sermon, according to Ecumenical News International.

Green had described homosexuality as "abnormal, a horrible cancerous tumor in the body of society" in a 2003 sermon.

Soren Andersson, the president of the Swedish Federation for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender rights, said on hearing Green's jail sentence that religious freedom could never be used as a reason to offend people.
