Catriona, hello. We don't understand your point about doing a balanced piece on the dismembering of unborn children. Would you have done a balanced piece on the gassing of Jews or the lynching of blacks? Neutrality in the face of inhumanity is hatred. So we urge you to soften your hard heart against the killing of children.

Although we care more about you than your article, and although you should resign rather than write the kind of piece that the BBC would accept without firing you, here's your quote from American Right To Life:

The intentional killing of any child violates God's enduring command, Do not murder. And it doesn't matter whether someone says they believe in God or not. Those who kill the innocent will be judged unless they turn to Christ for forgiveness. The life-of-the-mother "exception" is exposed as a lie because removing, not poisoning or dismembering, the baby boy or girl is the loving way to save the mother. A real doctor would never delay the effort to save mom just long enough to kill the baby.
