Gen 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep were broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. 12 And the rain was on the earth forty days and forty nights. 13 On the very same day Noah and Noah's sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth, and Noah's wife and the three wives of his sons with them, entered the ark — 14 they and every beast after its kind, all cattle after their kind, every creeping thing that creeps on the earth after its kind, and every bird after its kind, every bird of every sort. 15 And they went into the ark to Noah, two by two, of all flesh in which is the breath of life. 16 So those that entered, male and female of all flesh, went in as God had commanded him; and the Lord shut him in.

Luke 17:22 Then He said to the disciples, "The days will come when you will desire to see one of the days of the Son of Man, and you will not see it. 23 And they will say to you, 'Look here!' or 'Look there!' Do not go after them or follow them. 24 For as the lightning that flashes out of one part under heaven shines to the other part under heaven, so also the Son of Man will be in His day. 25 But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation. 26 And as it was in the days of Noah, so it will be also in the days of the Son of Man: 27 They ate, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark, and the flood

came and destroyed them all. 28 Likewise as it was also in the days of Lot: They ate, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they built; 29 but on the day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed them all. NKJV

1. Where did water come from?

According to the bible the water to flood the earth came from the great deep

Explain how there was an ocean under the 60 mile thick crust, and portions of crust were touching the mantle as pillars

Explain tidal pumping

Explain supercritical water – greater than 702 degrees F.

Able to dissolve the subterranean chamber ceiling and floor.

Provided the minerals necessary to cement the sedimentary layers

The crust failed – depressurization resulted in thermal energy being converted to kinetic energy

Fountains of the great deep ocean of water are now being unleashed into space and/or the earth's surface

2. How did it flood the entire earth – considering current topography?

The mountains of today were created as a result of the flood, they were much lower in elevation before the flood, and were flattened during the flood to make for a nearly smooth spherical earth.

Evidence -Sea shell fossils and shark teeth on all mountain ranges, huge fossilized clams at 12,000 feet in the Andes
