Gen 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep were broken up,

Where water come from? – The fountains of the great deep - the ocean of water between the crust and mantle

Extreme velocity at first, causing the earth’s crust to flutter

Gen 7:11---- and the windows of heaven were opened. 12 And the rain was on the earth forty days and forty nights.

What does it mean “the windows of heaven were opened?”

Water returning from space that did not have enough velocity to escape earth

Or:

Canopy theory

It was first proposed by atheist Isaac Newton Vail in 1874, but adopted, without credit, and promoted, by Henry M. Morris, Jr. And John Whitcomb in 1961 in their otherwise important book, *The Genesis Flood*.

Even if it could explain where the water came from, where could the water have gone?

Gen 7:12 And the rain was on the earth forty days and forty nights.

Rained 40 days and nights

Explain problems with global rainfall from a heat transfer standpoint

Gen 7:17 Now the flood was on the earth forty days. The waters increased and lifted up the ark, and it rose high above the earth. 18 The waters prevailed and greatly increased on the earth, and the ark moved about on the surface of the waters. 19 And the waters prevailed exceedingly on the earth, and all the high hills under the whole heaven were covered.

Global – cannot be a local flood

Gen 7:20 The waters prevailed fifteen cubits upward, and the mountains were covered.

22.5 feet at the highest mountain - but earth relatively a flat sphere allowing for all land to be covered by water

How did the water keep going up? Because water was still coming out from under the crust until the 150th day (five months)

Gen 7:21 And all flesh died that moved on the earth: birds and cattle and beasts and every creeping thing that creeps on the earth, and every man. 22 All in whose nostrils was the breath of the spirit of life, all that was on the dry land, died.

Global flood, cannot be local

All the layered strata where formed in horizontal layers

Liquefaction sorted it –

Biblical summary of where the water came from:

2 Peter 3:5 For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, 6 by which the world that then existed perished, being flooded with water. 7 But the heavens and the earth which are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and

perdition of ungodly men. NKJV

Gen 7:23 So He destroyed all living things which were on the face of the ground: both man and cattle, creeping thing and bird of the air. They were destroyed from the earth. Only Noah and those who were with him in the ark remained alive.

Global

Gen 7:24 And the waters prevailed on the earth one hundred and fifty days.

How did the waters continue to increase until the 150th day? – Water kept on coming out from under the crust

Where did the water go?

Crack widens

Providing debris which became the average mile thick sedimentary layers on the earth

Mantle bulged up into the widening crack

Caused the continents to move away from the Mid Oceanic Ridge, causing the crust to buckle and thicken into mountains, opening up large ocean basins for the water to run off into.
