"In you, all the families of the earth will be blessed."


Messiah will be a descendent of Abram (Abraham).

Melchizedek - Genesis 14:18-20

Abram gives a tenth (tithe) of all to Melchizedek

Melchizedek

- Means "King of Righteousness"
- Was King of Salem (Jerusalem) in Abraham's day




"Blessed be Abram of God Most High,

into your hand."


- 1. The greater blesses the lesser.
- 2. The lesser tithes to the greater.
- 3. Therefore, Melchizedek is greater than Abraham.

Melchizedek blesses Abram


Lineage of the Abrahamic Covenant & Priesthood



Duties of the Levitical / Aaronic Priesthood




Attempts to Usurp the Priesthood



- Tried but failed to usurp the High Priesthood of Aaron
- God judged: Earth opened and buried all the who rebelled
- Only Aaron's rod budded when placed on the Ark of the Covenant

Lesson: No one but Aaron can be the High Priest

- Wears the ephod of the High Priest Ex. 29:4-5; 1 Sam. 30:7-8; 2 Sam. 6:13-14; 1 Chron. 15:26-27.
- Eats from the Table of Showbread Lev. 24:5-9; 1 Sam. 21:4-6; Matt. 12:1-4.
- Goes to the Ark of the Covenant 2 Sam. 6:17-18, 7:18-29.

- Fulfilled Psalm 110
- Eternal King and Priest according to the order of Melchizedek

SUMMARY

- Only God appoints priests
- Only three priesthoods through all of history
 - 1. Melchizedek (Greater)
 - 2. Aaron (Lesser)
 - 3. Jesus (Greatest, Supreme, Eternal)



- Those who attempt to usurp the priesthood were judged by God. Exceptions:
 - David Because God was hinting at the fulfillment (by Jesus, the Son of David) of Psalm 110, written by David. Matthew 22:41-46
 - Hezekiah Because he came to God in humility. An example of all who come humbly to the Throne of Grace by faith in Jesus.
