'This Is Not the End of Democracy': Netanyahu Won't Cave to Leftists, Will Advance Judicial Reform

"Immediately after the election results, I said that I intend to be the prime minister of all the citizens of Israel," Netanyahu <u>began</u>. "I meant it then, and I mean it even today. We have one country and we must do everything to protect it from outside threats and from an irreparable rupture."

"We cannot allow any dispute, no matter how acute, to endanger the common future," added Netanyahu, "we must reject ...
