## **Hebrews 10:1-14**

## He has Perfected Forever those who are Being Sanctified April 2, 2023 S-1534-KL

## All verses are from the New King James Version, 1985 Thomas Nelson

Hebrews 9:24 For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands [*Temple in Jerusalem*], which are copies of the true, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us; 25 not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another —26 He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. 27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, 28 so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who **eagerly** wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

2 Tim 4:6 For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have **kept the faith**. 8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also **to all who have loved His appearing**.

Hebrews 10:1 For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach **perfect** [complete]. 2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had **no more consciousness** of sins. 3 But in those sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. 4 For it is **not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins**.

Col 2:8 Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ. 9 For in Him [Jesus] dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 10 and you are complete [perfect] in Him, who is the head of all principality and power.

Heb 9:13 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, 14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, <u>cleanse your conscience</u> from dead works to serve the living God?

Ps 51:12 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit. 13 Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners shall be converted to You. 14 Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, the God of my salvation, and my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness. 15 O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth shall show forth Your praise. 16 For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give it; You do not delight in burnt offering. 17 The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart — These, O God, You will not despise.

Hebrews 10:5 Therefore, when He [*Jesus*] came into the world, He said (*Psalm 40:6-8 Septuagint*): "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, but a body You have prepared for Me. 6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. 7 Then I [*Jesus*] said, 'Behold, I have come — In the volume of the book it is written of Me — To do Your will, O God.'" 8 Previously saying, "Sacrifice and offering, burnt

offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them" (which are offered according to the law),

Isa 1:11 "To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices to Me?" Says the Lord. "I have had enough of burnt offerings of rams and the fat of fed cattle. I do not delight in the blood of bulls, or of lambs or goats. 12 "When you come to appear before Me, who has required this from your hand, to trample My courts? 13 Bring no more futile sacrifices; incense is an abomination to Me. The New Moons, the Sabbaths, and the calling of assemblies — I cannot endure iniquity and the sacred meeting. 14 Your New Moons and your appointed feasts My soul hates; they are a trouble to Me, I am weary of bearing them.

Hebrews 10:9 then He said (*Psalm 40*), "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." He [*Jesus*] takes away the first that He may establish the second. 10 By that will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. 11 And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. 12 But this Man [*Jesus*], after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, 13 from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool.

Rom 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

Hebrews 10:14 For by one offering [himself] He has perfected **forever** those who are being sanctified.
