Jesus Came with a Mission to Save Us from Our Sins

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. **Go to verse 14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. **Back to verse 3** All things were made through Him [*Jesus*], and without Him [*Jesus*] nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him [*Jesus*] was life, and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. **Go to verse 9** That [*Jesus*] was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. 10 He [*Jesus*] was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. 11 He [*Jesus*] came to His own [*the Jews*], and His own did not receive Him.

John 1:12 **But as many as received Him**, to them He [*Jesus*] gave the right to become children of God, **to those who believe in His name**: 13 who [*those who believe in His name*] were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. 14 And the Word [*Jesus*] became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, **full of grace and truth**. **Go to verse 16** And of His [*Jesus*] fullness **we have all received**, and **grace for grace**. 17 **For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.**

Luke 1:26 Now in the sixth month **the angel Gabriel** was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, 27 to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. 28 And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!" 29 But when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. 30 Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

Luke 1:31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, **and shall call His name Jesus**. 32 He will be great, and will be called the **Son of the Highest**; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. 33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end." 34 Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?"

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel [*meaning "God with us"*].

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born **will be called the Son of God**. 36 Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. **37 For with God nothing will be impossible.**"

Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was **betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit**. 19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly.

Deut 22:23 "If a young woman who is a virgin is betrothed to a husband, and a man finds her in the city and lies with her, 24 then you shall bring them both out to the gate of that city, and you shall stone them to death with stones, the young woman because she did not cry out in the city, and the man because he humbled his neighbor's wife; so you shall put away the evil from among you.

Matthew 1:20 But while he thought about these things, behold, **an angel** of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. 21 And she will bring forth a Son, and you **shall call His name Jesus**, for He will **save His people from their sins**." 22 So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

Leviticus 18:4 You shall observe My judgments and keep My ordinances, to walk in them: I am the Lord your God. 5 You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, which if a man does, **he shall live by them**: I am the Lord.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 8:23 And He said to them [unbelieving Scribes and Pharisees], "You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. 24 Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; **for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins**." 25 Then they said to Him, "Who are You?" And Jesus said to them, "Just what I have been saying to you from the beginning.

Jeremiah 31:33 But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. 34 No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. **For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.**"

John 1:12 **But as many as received Him**, to them He [*Jesus*] gave the right to become children of God, **to those who believe in His name**:

Romans 10:8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
