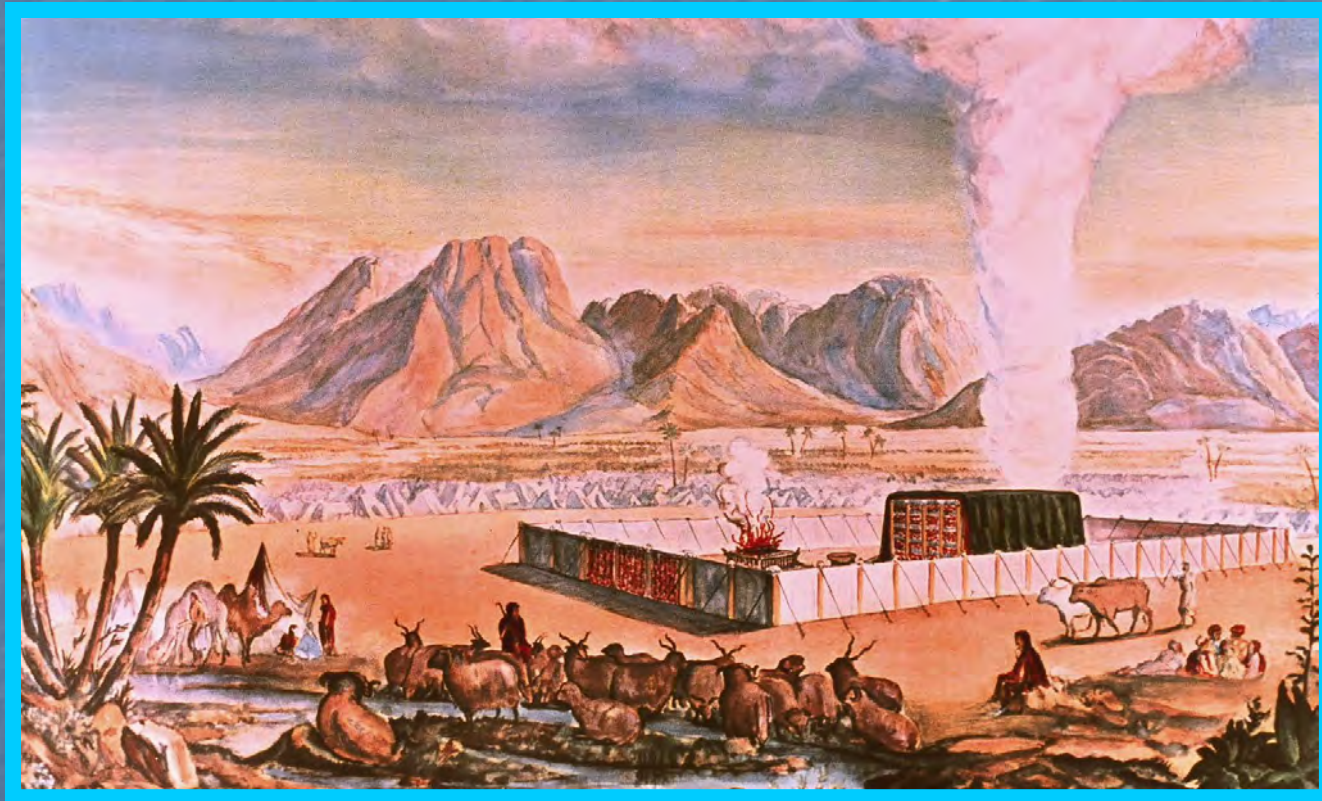


# Exodus Chapter 38 Tabernacle Verses



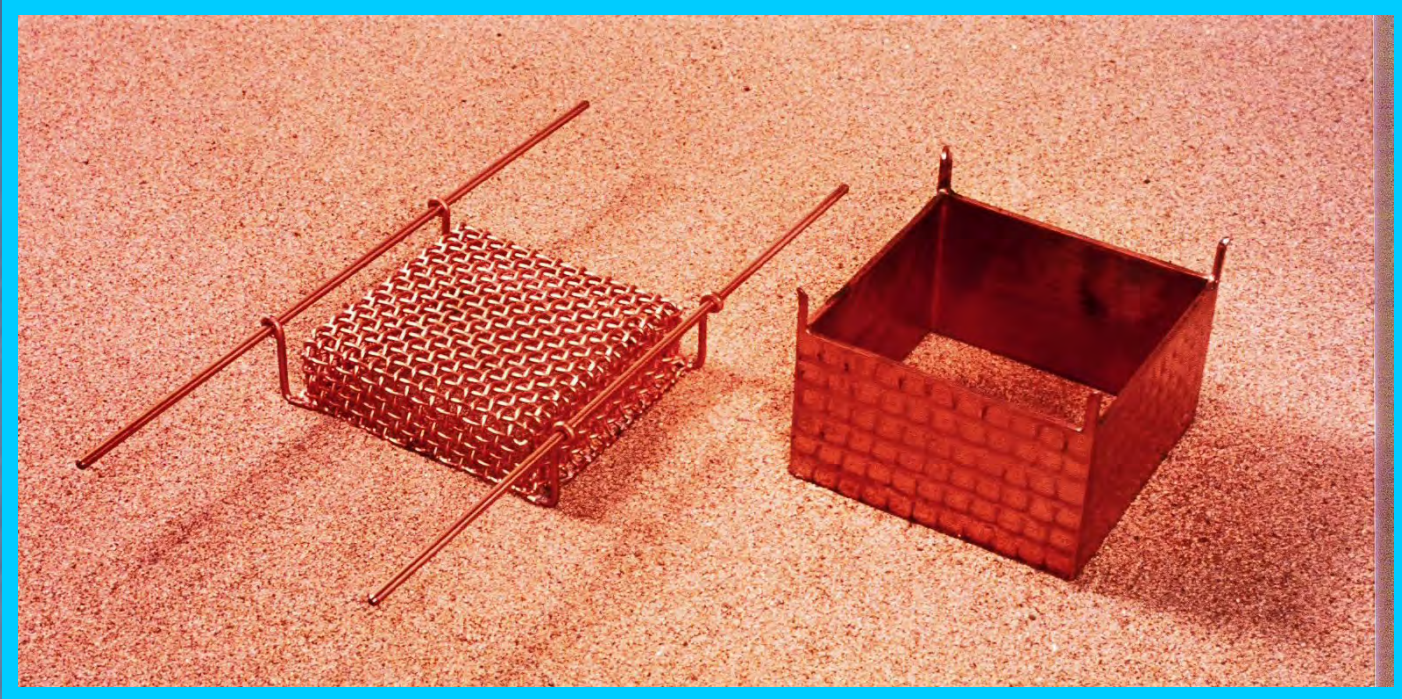

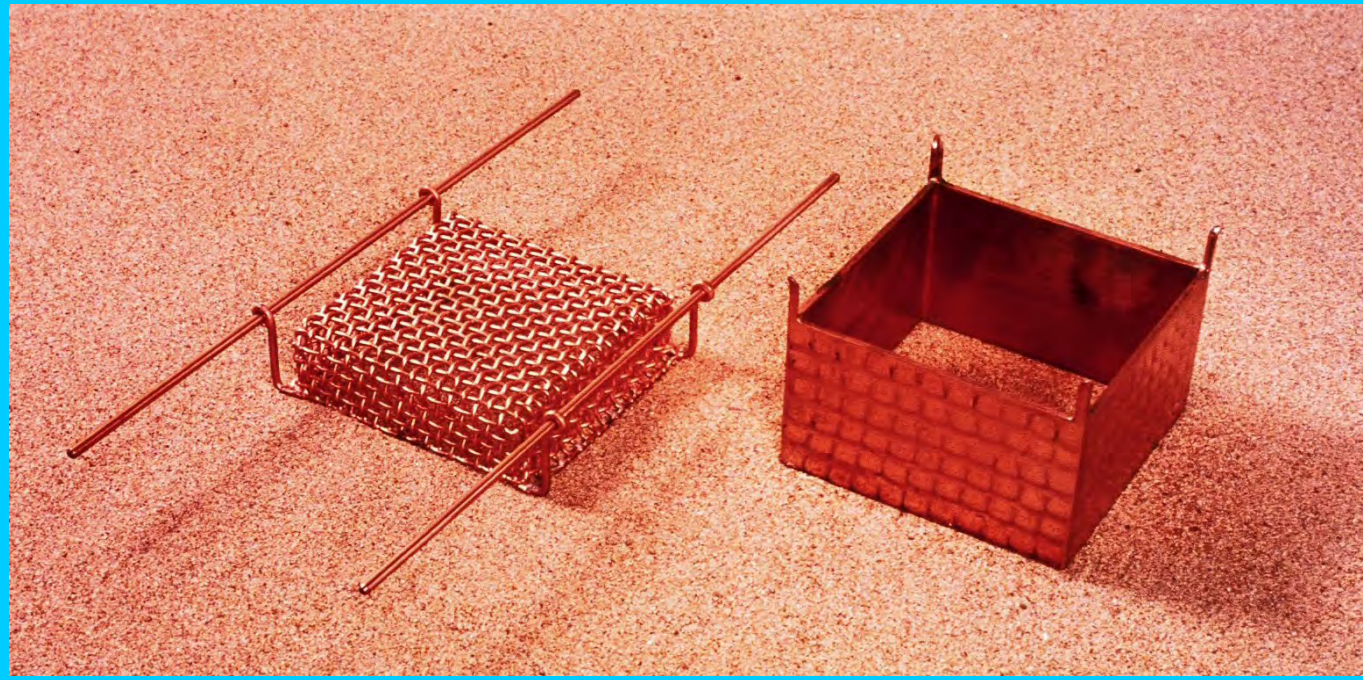

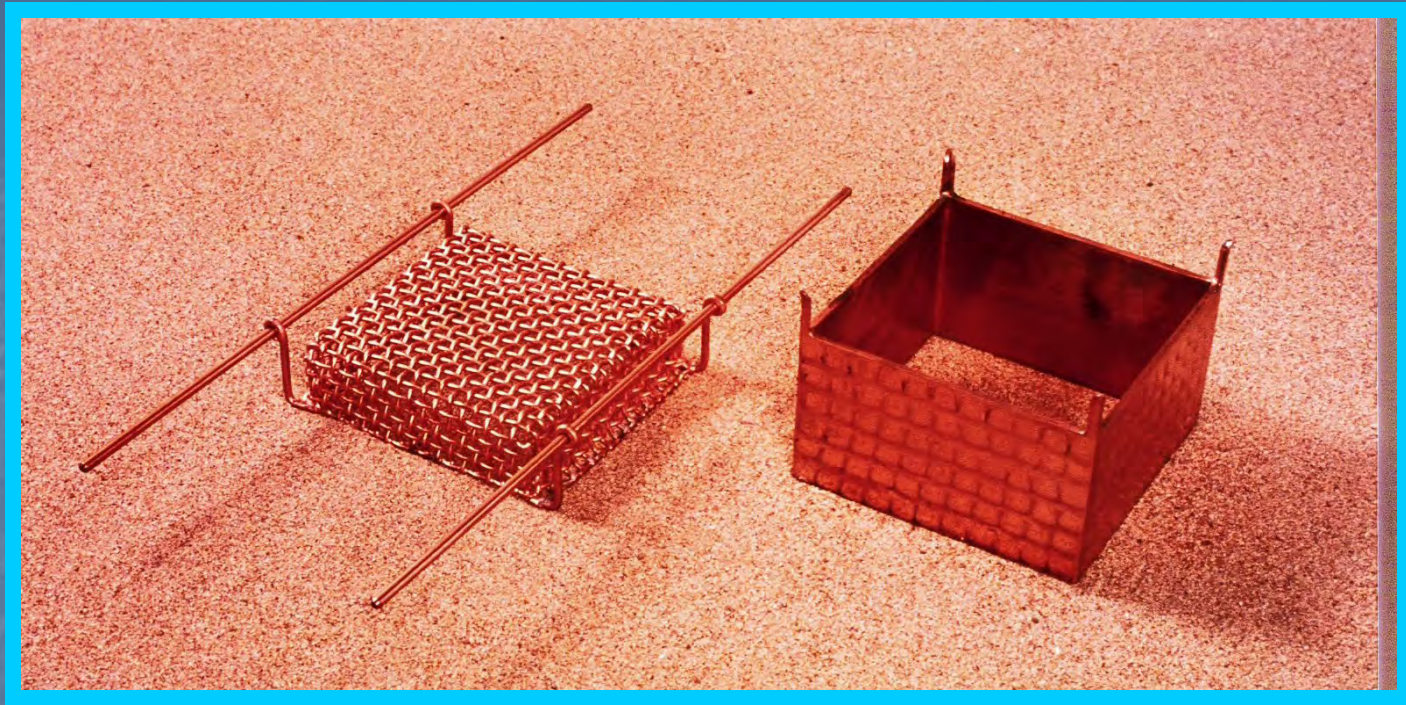
Exodus 38:1 He made the altar of burnt offering of acacia wood; five cubits (*7.5 feet*) was its length and five cubits its width — it was square — and its height was three cubits (*4.5 feet*).





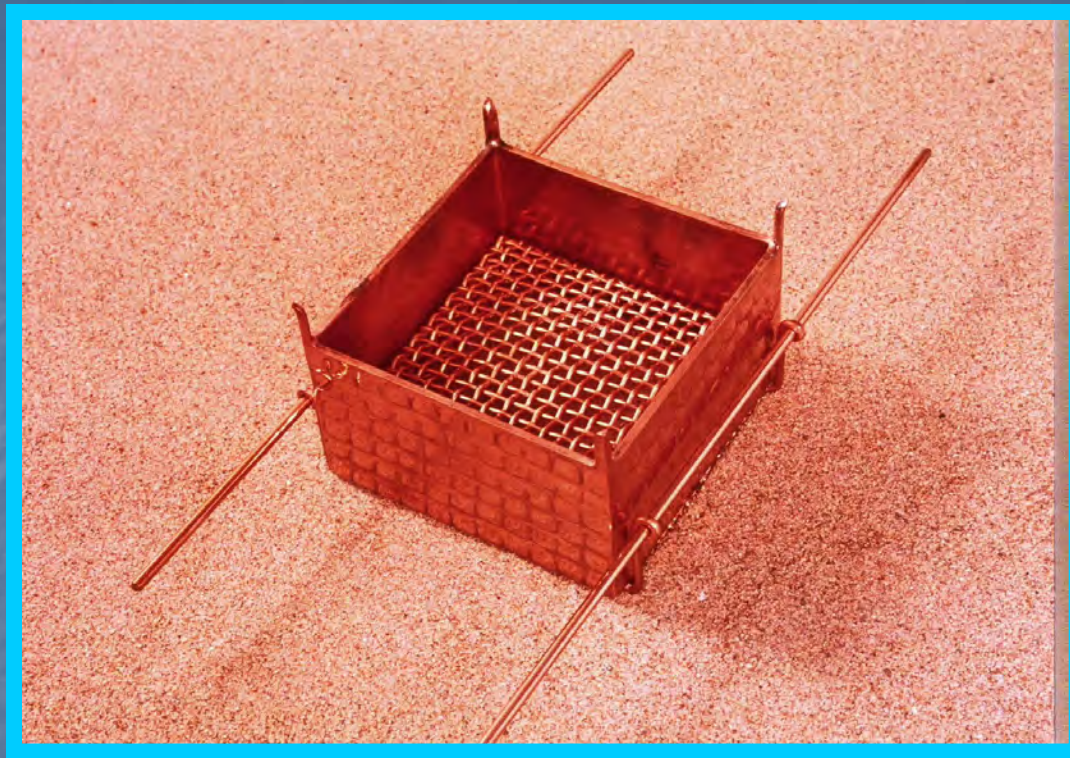
Exodus 38:2 He made its horns on its four corners; the horns were of one piece with it. And he overlaid it with bronze.





1 Kings 2:28 Then news came to Joab, for Joab had defected to Adonijah, though he had not defected to Absalom. So Joab fled to the tabernacle of the Lord, and took hold of the horns of the altar.

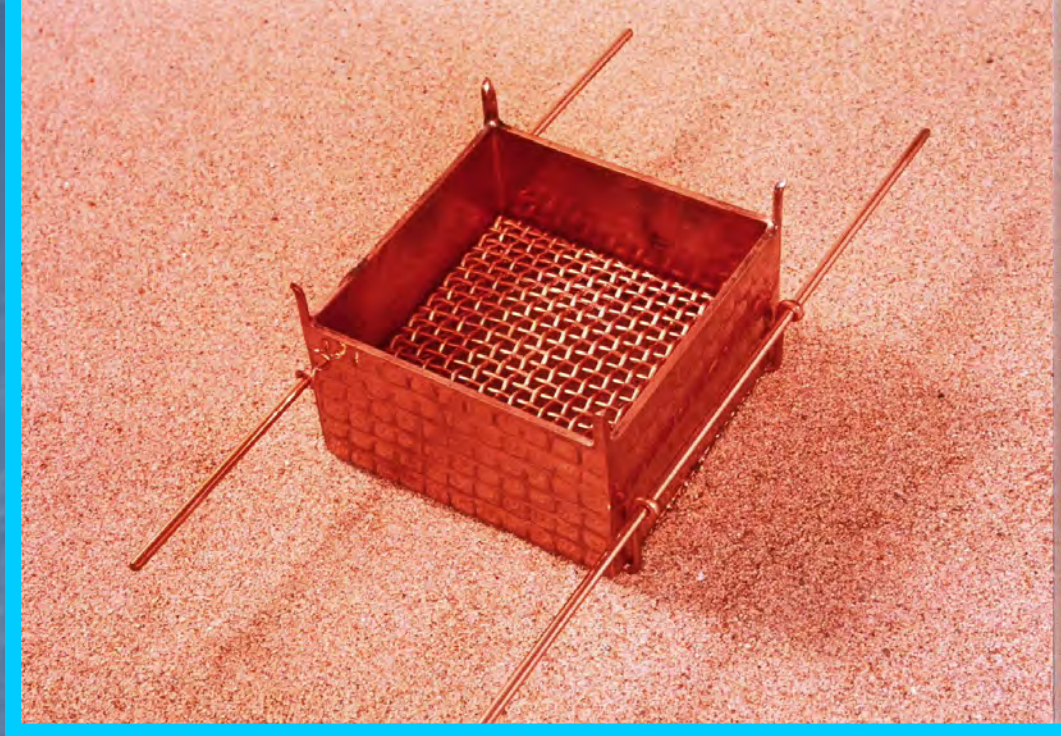




Exodus 38:3 He made all the utensils for the altar: the pans, the shovels, the basins, the forks, and the firepans; all its utensils he made of bronze (*symbolic of judgment*).

4 And he made a grate of bronze network for the altar, under its rim, midway from the bottom.





Exodus 38:5 He cast four rings for the four corners of the bronze grating, as holders for the poles. 6 And he made the poles of acacia wood, and overlaid them with bronze. 7 Then he put the poles into the rings on the sides of the altar, with which to bear it. He made the altar hollow with boards.





Exo 38:8 He made the laver of bronze and its base of bronze, from the bronze mirrors of the serving women who assembled at the door of the tabernacle of meeting.





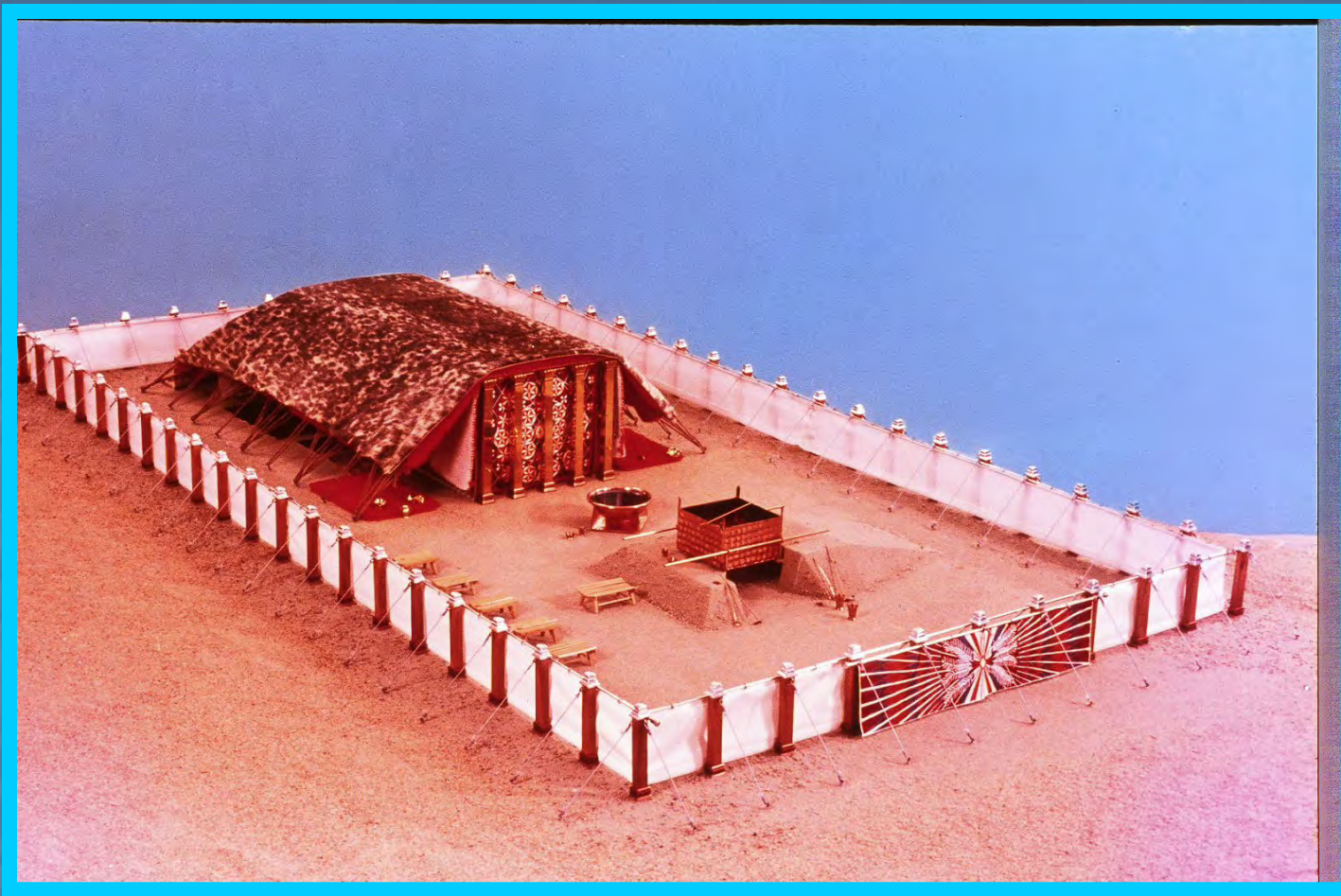
Exodus 30:20 When they go into the tabernacle of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn an offering made by fire to the Lord, they shall wash with water, lest they die. 21 So they shall wash their hands and their feet, lest they die. And it shall be a statute forever to them — to him and his descendants throughout their generations."





John 13:9 Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!" 10 Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you." 11 For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "You are not all clean."





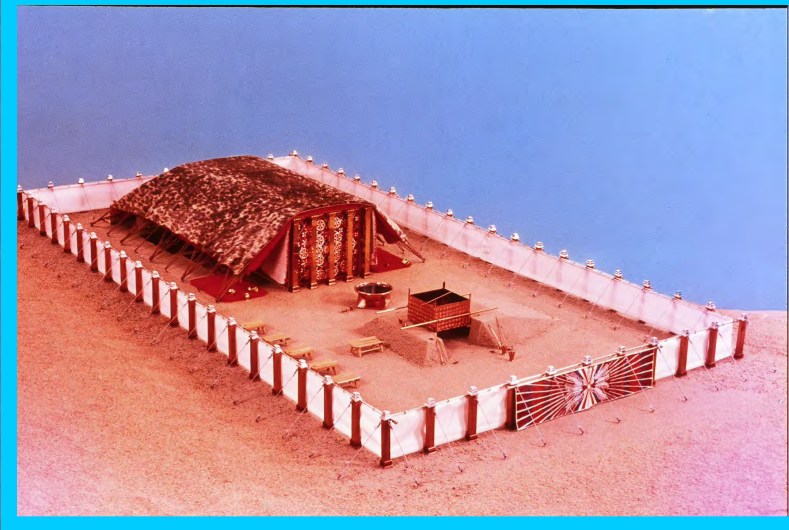
Exo 38:9 Then he made the court on the south side; the hangings of the court were of fine woven linen, one hundred cubits long (*150 feet, half the length of a football field*).



Exodus 38:10 There were twenty pillars for them, with twenty bronze sockets. The hooks of the pillars and their bands were silver.



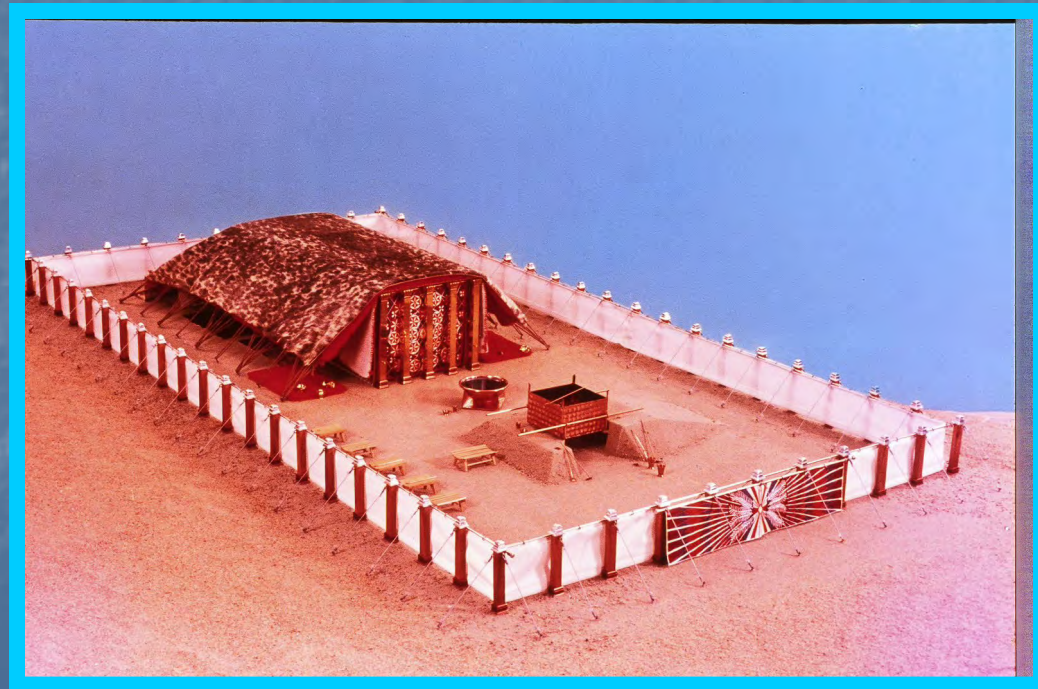




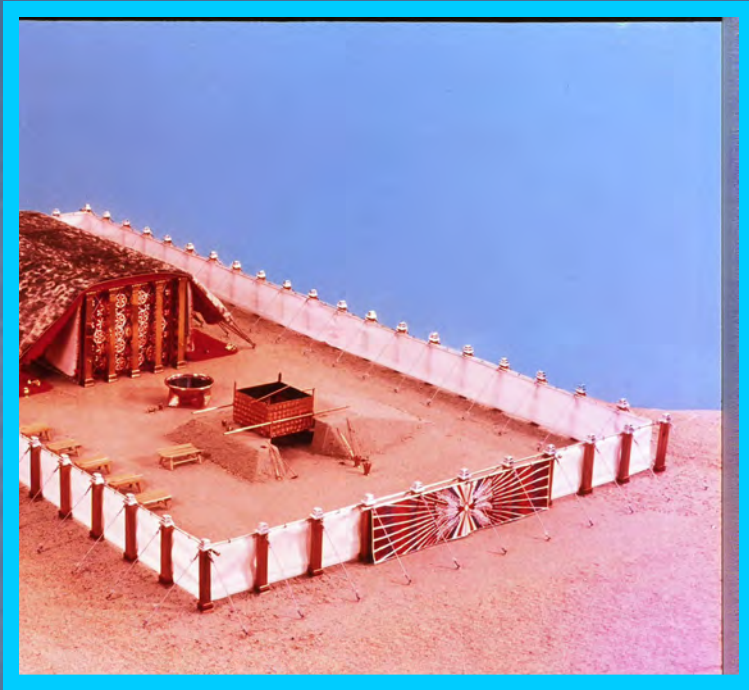
Exo 38:11 On the north side the hangings were one hundred cubits long, with twenty pillars and their twenty bronze sockets. The hooks of the pillars and their bands were silver.



Exodus 38:12 And on the west side there were hangings of fifty cubits (*75 feet, ten feet short of being half the width of a football field*), with ten pillars and their ten sockets. The hooks of the pillars and their bands were silver.



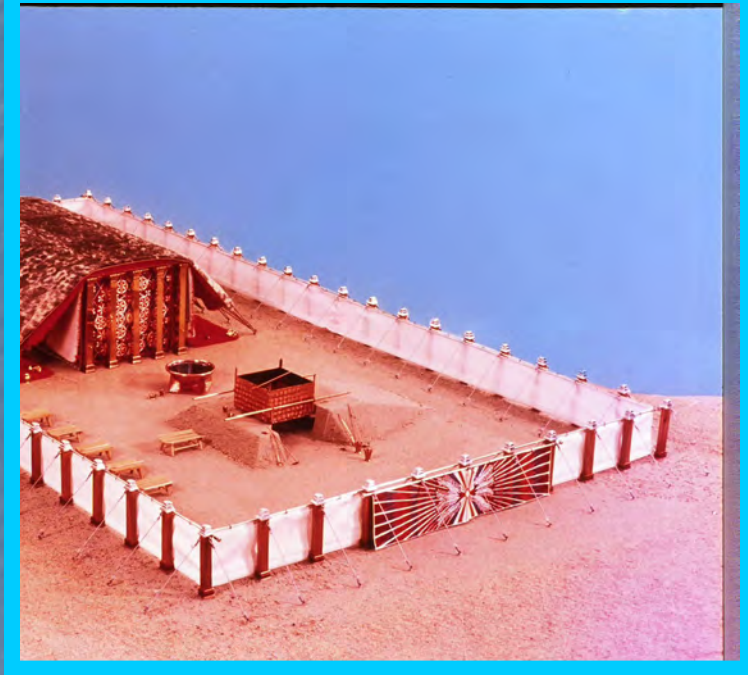




Exodus 38:13 For the east side the hangings were fifty cubits. 14 The hangings of one side of the gate were fifteen cubits long, with their three pillars and their three sockets,

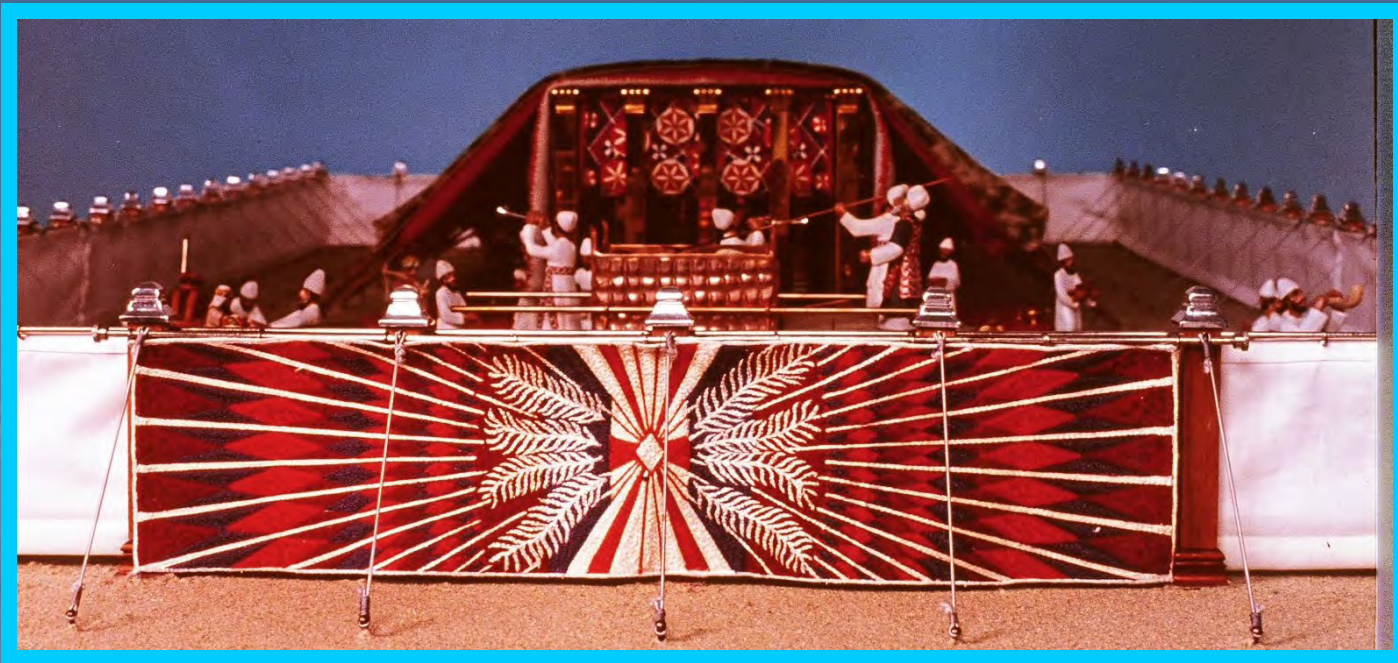
15 and the same for the other side of the court gate; on this side and that were hangings of fifteen cubits, with their three pillars and their three sockets *(total of 45 of the 75 feet were permanent shared between the two sides of the entry door).*





Exodus 38:16 All the hangings of the court all around were of fine woven linen. 17 The sockets for the pillars were bronze, the hooks of the pillars and their bands were silver, and the overlay of their capitals was silver; and all the pillars of the court had bands of silver.





Exo 38:18 The screen for the gate of the court was woven of blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and of fine woven linen. The length was twenty cubits (*the remaining 30 feet of the total 75 feet*), and the height along its width was five cubits (*7.5 feet high*), corresponding to the hangings of the court.





Exo 38:19 And there were four pillars with their four sockets of bronze; their hooks were silver, and the overlay of their capitals and their bands was silver. 20 All the pegs of the tabernacle, and of the court all around, were bronze.
