Are Recent Scientific Discoveries Validating Dr. Walt Brown's Hydroplate Theory and Discrediting Catastrophic Plate Tectonics?

On February 6, 2025, I sent the following email to Dr. Tim Clarey who is the Director of Research for the Institute for Creation Research (ICR), headquartered in Dallas Texas.

The purpose of the email was to get Dr. Clarey's opinion on two recent discoveries about nucleotides and amino acids being found on the asteroid Bennu (strongly supports Dr. Walt Brown's theory on the origins of asteroids) and a November 24, 2024, Nature article titled, Full-Wavefore Inversion Reveals Diverse Origins of Lower Mantle Positive Wave Speed Anomalies

The authors of the Nature article all have a Plate Tectonic paradigm. Their discoveries using a more accurate method of seismic tomography to map the inner earth were surprising to them, causing them to question the validity of interpreting certain seismic anomalies near trenches as proof of subducting plates. Their revelation was in finding the same kind of anomalies in areas of the mantle that were thousands of miles from plate boundaries. They concluded that since these anomalies could not be subducting plates, the previous interpretations of the same anomalies near plate boundaries should now be questioned.

For decades Dr. John Baumgardner and those who have embraced his Catastrophic Plate Tectonic (CPT) Theory explanation for the flood of Noah (including Dr. Clarey) have been insistent that they know they are right because seismic tomography has proven plate subduction. When confronted with the facts of physics that would prevent their run-away plate subduction from starting, continuing, or stopping, they respond by invoking miracles reasoning that they know plates are subducting, and since God is a miracle working God, He used whatever miracles were necessary to make CPT work.

After reading the Nature article and in light of the multiple scientific discoveries about asteroids and comets which are shocking to everyone except Hydroplate Theory advocates, I thought that Dr. Clarey and Dr. Baumgardner might be willing to throw in the towel on CPT. Of course doing so would understandably take a lot of courage since they have dedicated their entire professional and creation science lives to being advocates of what is increasingly becoming more untenable.

My concluding question to Dr. Clarey was, "Let me know if you still hold to CPT being a fact or if you want to join me and other HPT advocates with giving reasons from Genesis for these recent discoveries."

Dr. Clarey and several others who were on cc. responded to my email and are included in this communication thread below. My comments to each response are indented with a different and italicized font.

Dear Dr. Clarey,

By way of reminder, it has been over two years since I had the privilege of meeting you and other ICR scientific staff at the ICR headquarters in Dallas when I and others presented Dr. Walt Brown's Hydroplate Theory as it relates to the origin of Asteroids, Comets and TNOs (CATNOs).

Last September 5th, I also had the privilege of meeting (via zoom) Nathan Van Farowe as we both participated in a CPT vs. HPT roundtable discussion/debate. During that discussion, Nathan conceded that seismic tomography does NOT determine the temperature profiles of the inner earth, but rather the density. I then stated that it is scientifically inaccurate for CPT advocates to teach that we see a cold subducting plate (claimed as proof of PT/CPT).

Now I have come across the attached peer-reviewed, 2024 (can't find the day or month), article out of Nature. [update: Full-waveform inversion reveals diverse origins of lower mantle positive wave speed anomalies November 4, 2024]

The authors state that seismic tomography is not able to determine temperature or even determine if what they see is a subducting plate. Here are a couple quotes from the 13-page article:

Many of these previously undetected anomalies are situated below major oceans and continental interiors, with no geologic record of subduction, such as beneath the western Pacific Ocean. Moreover, we find no statistically significant correlation positive anomalies as imaged using full-waveform inversion and past subduction.

Here, we analyse Earth's seismic wave speed structure constructed using full-waveform inversion (FWI), which has greater volumetric sensitivity to Earth's mantle than travel-time tomography. Global FWI reveals a much more complex, heterogeneous mantle seismic wave speed structure than traditionally imaged ^{43–45}. In particular, it reveals numerous large, positive wave speed anomalies in the mid- and lower mantle, even below major oceans and continental interiors with low seismic activity and/or limited station coverage, and importantly, no geologic record of subduction (Figs. 1, 2, 3).

As I commented to Nathan last September, HPT explains (because of the melting of large portions of the inner earth and increasing density of magma below 220 miles) how there could be density differences that are being falsely interpreted as subducting plates. Now this Nature article seems to further dispel the notion that CPT is proven because we have **seen** subducting plates, which brings me to the reason for this email to you.

I have copied Nathan and Dr. Baumgardner so that you can all read this article (if you have not already) and then inform me if you disagree with its authors and still believe seismic tomography data proves PT/CPT.

However, if you agree that the science and conclusions of this article, i.e. that anomalies in seismic tomography data cannot accurately be interpreted as subducting plates, then I would like to hear

from you on how you think the creation/flood science ministries should respond based on this new information.

Last September, after Nathan and I had concluded our presentation points and counter points, Nathan conceded that the evidence I presented about space probe discoveries were explained (and can only be explained) by HPT. He said something like, 'Maybe you are right about Comets and Asteroids being from the earth, but we (CPT advocates) are right about geophysics on earth.' I responded that if HPT advocates are right on the origin of Comets and Asteroids, then CPT cannot be true.

Since our September roundtable discussion/debate, numerous articles have and are coming out with the fact that the asteroid Bennu samples contain all five of the nucleotides for DNA and 14 of the 20 amino acids that are needed for all life. They also found multiple minerals that can only form in the presence of liquid salt water. Links to just three of these youtube/facebook blogs are provided below. Tim, as you know from our presentation at ICR in December of 2022, these asteroid sample results are expected and were predicted by HPT. Of course, the secular world is spinning these findings as proof of transpermia, but all young earth creationists should know better.

Therefore, the young earth creation science community is left with three options:

 All samples from asteroids and comets that are returned to earth are contaminated even though millions of dollars have been invested in clean rooms with the goal of making that impossible. Of course, this does not answer why the space probes that are sent to asteroids and comets have detected (using on-board sensors at a distance) complex organic molecules, and minerals that only form in liquid water, thus ruling out contamination.

- 2. God created comets and asteroids during the creation week with evidence of life (including bacteria) on them. This would include creating these objects in space in a near perfect vacuum and near absolute zero temperature with the building blocks of all life and had abundant liquid salt water at some time in the past.
- 3. Dr. Brown was right when decades ago, based on all the volumes of research he poured into determining the origin of these heavenly bodies was right when he concluded their origins were best explained by, "In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains [of water, not magma] of the great deep were broken up, and the windows of heaven [into and some back from space] were opened. I pray all organizations will make the biblical/logical choice of number 3 above (unless they think there is another option that is better) and then use all of their talents to get the word out to Christian masses so that they don't have to struggle in their faith over the world telling them that life came to earth from space.



Thanks, Kevin. I had read this article myself a week ago, but it is a good reminder of the things the old-earth community finds baffling. And there was another article by another group late last year who found similar **COId** [emphasis added] anomalies on top of the core.

<u>Pastor Kevin response</u>: Nathan Van Farowe conceded during our Sept 2024 Zoom debate that seismic tomography does **not** determine the temperature of anything in the mantle. It only determines changes in density. After admitting this point, he continued to say the anomalies are a result of cold slabs, the same as Dr. Clarey is mistakenly saying here. I will be giving a chance for Dr. Clarey to correct his false statement before posting this at hydroplate.org. – At posting time, Dr. Clarey had not corrected this false statement



As the Japanese discovered in 2006, "The basaltic magma could not ascend from a position deeper than 200km in the Earth's interior"

Anomalous Compression of Basaltic Magma: Implications to Pressure-Induced Structural Change in Silicate Melt. When basalt melts below the extreme pressures at 200km and below, the resulting hot magma can only descend through the mantle toward the liquid core, increasing in density during the entire descent, and thus cannot ascend toward the mid-oceanic ridges as CPT posits. This fact makes CPT a non-starter, unless miracles are invoked.

Instead of seeing "cold anomalies on top of the [liquid] core", seismic tomography is seeing areas of the lower mantle that have

much higher density than mantle material near by.

HPT can and does explain this as areas where, as a result of the movement of mantle material from the Pacific to Atlantic side of the earth (See Dr. Brown's preliminary 9th edition Trench Chapter at hydroplate.org), the frictional heat melted some of the solid mantle. At pressures existing deep in the earth, when the mantle rock melts, it contracts (becomes denser) and is headed down to the liquid core when deformation of the inner earth and earthquakes allow for it to do so, thus increasing the volume of the liquid core.

So instead of seeing cold areas near the liquid core, we are seeing areas where the mantle has melted (gotten hotter and denser). These density anomalies are expected by HPT to be found all over the mantle, especially in the Atlantic and Pacific, which is exactly what the Nature article states that they discovered.

The Nature authors were shocked and have no explanation for these density anomalies because it does not fit their Plate Tectonics and related CPT paradigm, thinking previous studies were proof of cold subducting plates. However, the Hydroplate Theory paradigm

predicts these **density** anomalies are a result of melting of the inner earth, with density increasing when the mantle melts before the 200km crossover depth.

It should also be noted that geo-engineers have a history of making bad predictions based on interpreting seismic tomography anomalies: What did the Soviets discover in the Kola Superdeep well at a depth of 12,262 meters

Since Dr. Baumgardner is agreeably the recognized expert on seismic tomography, I am hoping he will trade his CPT glasses for an HPT pair and in doing so become an expert on the real explanation for these melted areas of the mantle which may allow Christians to be known as the ones who allowed us to better understand/predict earthquakes.

Dr. Clarey response: - At posting time – no response

Dr. Clarey email to Kevin cont: Both of these teams unknowingly confirmed runaway subduction! The **COld** [emphasis added] slabs deep in the earth are the remnants of oceanic lithosphere that sank into the mantle 4500 years ago. They are still **COld** [emphasis added] because they didn't take 70 million years to sink to the base of the mantle (1800 miles). If so, they would have heated up and assimilated to the temperatures at the base of the mantle by now (3700 degrees C). Instead, these data confirm that the subducted plates were emplaced recently, in the Flood year by catastrophic plate motion of meters per second. It is only a mystery to the old-earth community who insist on slow plate motion like we see today.

<u>Pastor Kevin response</u>: I beg to differ that the Nature article confirms runaway subduction. Having read the article and watched the related youtube clips, I strongly suspect that the authors would robustly agree with me that there is no plausible speed of supposed ocean-plate plunging into the mantle that would explain all the high density (not cold) locations in the mantle.

There are 20 reasons why (apart from invoked miracles) that PT/CPT cannot occur.

Basalt and granite are completely different rocks and densities too. The minerals would all have to be changed.

Also, I would like to hear from you about the second part of my email to you pertaining to the discoveries on asteroids that are completely consistent with Dr. Brown's Hydroplate Theory (HPT). Don't you agree that if my option three is the truth, that CPT is dead?

HPT explains that the flood was a result of the fountains of the great deep (of subterranean water) all bursting up on one day, and the windows of heaven opening (sending debris into and some back from space?), causing global rainfall for 40 days and nights and continuing to have water increase to the 150th day when the entire earth, at one time, was flooded to at least 22.5 feet. 





Brian,

I believe that CPT does have an explanation for these latest findings. While secular plate tectonics cannot explain subducted pre-flood crust slabs ending up far from the subduction zones, it fits perfectly with CPT where plate velocities are a billion times faster. Observe the figure below from Baumgardner's model at day 30 of the flood.

The blue zone shows the **cold** [emphasis added] pre-flood crust already spreading along the core mantle boundary far from the subduction zone (the vertical blue line). There are still plenty of flood days left for the cold pre-flood ocean floor to travel farther from the subduction zone. The second figure is actual data from global tomography that shows **cold** [emphasis added] zones spread along the core mantle boundary far from the subduction zone which aligns with the recent findings and Baumgardner's CPT model.

<u>Pastor Kevin response</u>: Dear Nathan, you told me last September that you knew seismic tomography does not tell the temperature of the inner earth. After admitting this fact, you then continued to talk about **cold** slabs subducting. Now, five months later, you are still apposed to communicating facts instead of wishful thinking. Even the Nature article admits that they are seeing density anomalies, not temperature anomalies. It is false to say that the normal temperature/density correlations on earth's surface are the same as in the mantle, and as stated in my first comment to this posting, we **know** temperature and density do not correlate in the mantle.

We do have a God-given example of temperature/density false thinking on earth. One could assume that as you cool water, its density will always increase. We know this is false, and aren't we glad because if it were true all lakes and other bodies of water would freeze from the bottom up.

Nathan Continued: At our church, recent messages have been about unity. In John 17:20-23, Jesus' number one prayer is for the unity of believers. In Philippians 1:15-18 Paul talks about others preaching Christ out of rivalry hoping to afflict Paul in his imprisonment. Paul was not afflicted but rejoiced because regardless of the motive Christ was preached. Young earth creationists should be focusing our efforts on unbelievers and those that may be led astray by secular science rather than rivalry amongst ourselves. Some may be swayed by HPT and recent findings from astronomy, others by CPT and recent advancements in the earth sciences, let us rejoice in both.

<u>Pastor Kevin response</u>: Four verses before Jesus is praying for the church to be unified He said in John 17:17, "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth."

Jesus sanctifies (sets apart) His church from the world around the truth of His word. Only then can there be unity. When people are led astray by falsehoods, the unity is lost.

We see this in all of the Apostle's epistles. The devil was constantly infiltrating the church with false doctrines creating division amongst the brethren. God used Paul and the other Apostles to vigorously refute the falsehoods and bring the saints back to the truth. Paul even rebuked Peter for the small infraction of compromising the gospel (Gal 2:11-14). Paul only rejoiced in unity with others if the true gospel (even if under ulterior motives) was preached, not a false gospel.

Although flood models are not the gospel, they can be used as an apologetic tool to combat the lies the devil is telling people who are trapped in the secular narrative. This could then open the person's heart to receive the true gospel.

But as I said in our debate last September, a flood model is only an apologetic tool if it is the truth, and then only if it does not invoke miracles to make it work. A secular student who rejects God is not going to be swayed to believe the biblical flood account with a multiple-miracle invoking theory.

But he/she may be challenged if everything they have been told by big-bangers and geologists about asteroids, comets, TNOs, the inner earth, etc. are all turning out to be false, and then they hear about a flood theory that is perfectly consistent with all the discovered facts of science about these topics and is also perfectly consistent with the seventy biblical scriptures addressing the flood (indicating divine authorship). That's what makes it an apologetic tool.

It is just as easy for Christians to come up with wishful thinking falsehoods as it is for the "secular" world. The result is the same; the student goes away believing a lie.

You say that the student can have faith in CPT because of the recent advancements in earth sciences. The whole purpose of my initial email was to point out that recent advancements are refuting PT/CPT, and then asking you and others the question, "How do you think the creation/flood science ministries should respond based on this new information?"

Therefore, Nathan, for the sake of unity, will you turn away from saying cold slabs are subducting, that CPT and HPT are both the truth?

Do you believe?



I kindly invite you to watch my presentation on <u>geophysics modeling</u> from last year's HPT conference or review the associated <u>paper</u>. The key issue—often overlooked—is that neither seismic tomography nor geophysics modeling can be black-box tested. In my years of experience in the engineering industry, this lack of verifiability is a critical flaw that undermines their practical usefulness. (For context, I served as the team lead of Micron's modeling department of NAND technology).

Too much confidence is often placed in subjective and abstract sciences, leading to speculative claims about what lies beneath the earth's surface being accepted as practical fact—despite a low probability of accuracy. This overreliance on untestable models raises significant concerns.

Unfortunately, within the YEC community, there remains a considerable divide between geologists/geophysicists and engineers. From my perspective, the voices of engineers have largely been dismissed. However, what we can see is an abundance of material with subsurface signatures of a watery environment—locations where secular scientists (and many CPT advocates) do not expect them. As I reflect on Psalm 1:1, especially on the words, "not sit in the seat of scoffers," I am strongly reluctant to join the sort of discussion to which you are inviting me. When I responded positively to the email from Rob Yardley, I had forgotten who you were, namely, Walt Brown's bulldog. I'm not sure when it was that Walt switched his model for the originally created earth from a 10-mile thick layer of granitic crust to a 60-mile thick layer, but I had not been aware of this truly astonishing change.

Kevin comment: This often-used argument from John is equivalent to someone bad-mouthing Ford car engineers because they didn't include a starter – in the early 1900s with their Model A. Thanks for the thoughtful question to Brian, which I am chiming in on below.

You ask,

Why do we not find <u>even a single meteorite</u> or single moon rock sample or single sample from an asteroid or comet that has a granitic composition? Is not this reality enough to falsify this notion that these objects were launched from the earth during the Flood?

Ans: Meteorites are known to be made of minerals, including iron, nickel, and silicates. The three main types of meteorites are stony, stony-iron, and iron.

According to the hydroplate theory. The pillars were iron/nickel, and some of their material crumbled and were sent out in the erupting fountains at escape velocity to become meteoroids and some have come back to become iron/nickel meteorites.

The lower part of the crust was also dissolved by the super critical water and jettisoned up in the fountains, some (including crust from the crumbling crack walls) falling back to become part of the average mile-thick sedimentary layers, and some being pulsed at escape velocity into space along with organic matter, top soil of the day, and from the walls of the granitic crust that was pulverized into millions of small boulders down to dust size that became the floating rock piles we now observe as comets/asteroids/TNOs (CATNOs)

Silicates are found in the Earth's crust making up approximately 90% of its composition, making them the most abundant mineral group in the crust; they are considered the primary rock-forming minerals.

Asteroids Bennu and Ryugu contain silicates, specifically a significant amount of hydrous phyllosilicates, meaning they are hydrated silicate minerals, which indicates a history of interaction with <u>liquid</u> water on both asteroids; analysis of samples from both bodies confirmed this composition.

Therefore, it is a fact that crustal material is being found on asteroids and comets. The evolutionists are shocked that no matter where they look, they keep finding the same thing. They are even saying that both Bennu and Ryugu must have come from the same "watery world". They are right, they did, and we (HPT advocates) call this watery world, "earth".

Granite minerals found on Asteroids and Sedimentary Layers

This addendum to the above was sent to John Baumgardner and others on Feb 27, 2025

On Feb 27, 2025 Kevin asked Google/AI the following three questions:

Could sedimentary rocks be made from minerals coming from granite?

AI - Yes, sedimentary layers can be made up of minerals that were once part of granite, as granite weathers and breaks down into smaller pieces (like quartz, feldspar, and mica) which can then be transported and deposited as sediment, eventually forming sedimentary rocks; essentially, granite can be a source material for sedimentary minerals.

Could minerals from granite be the source of samples brought back from asteroids?

AI - Yes, minerals commonly found in granite, like feldspar, mica, and quartz, could potentially be the source of some of the minerals found in samples brought back from certain asteroids, as the composition of many asteroids is similar to the early materials that formed the Earth's crust, including granite-like rocks.

What is the total weight of materials brought back from all space probes to asteroids and comets?

AI - As of today, the total weight of materials brought back from asteroids and comets by space probes is 121.6 grams (4.29 ounces), which was collected by the OSIRIS-REx mission from the asteroid Bennu.

Kevin – AI didn't answer the entire question and only gave the weight of samples from Bennu. I believe the total weight from all probes is still less than one pound.

HPT predicts that the more we are able to learn from asteroids, the more the evidence will support that they came from the earth as pulverized granite, mantle, topsoil and life from the pre-flood earth. What are CPT advocate predictions?



In recent years, there have been dozens of other discoveries about CATNOs that can only be explained by HPT.

Dr. Baumgardner's admitted lack of knowledge about HPT causes him to respond with,

"Another glaringly problematic aspect of the theory is its claim that processes internal to the earth somehow erupted all the comets and asteroids in our solar system from the earth during the Flood into their current trajectories. The energy source invoked for accomplishing this astonishing feat is sheer fantasy. It is indefensible in terms of any sort of honest science. How can believer endorse such fraud and thereby link it with the name of Jesus?"

Over one hundred years ago scientists with great self assurance proclaimed that things heavier than air could never fly. I would love to beam one of them into the present with a 747 flying over their head. For those who think HPT is a fraud, the equivalent to the 747 is the asteroid Bennu with nucleotides and amino acids.





I am still hoping that someday Dr. Baumgardner or Clarey will provide their answer to this question which until now they have ignored:

Which of the three options that I proposed earlier is the best answer for young earth creationist to have when people ask us? I and all young earth creationists want to hear your answer.

- 1. All samples from asteroids and comets that are returned to earth are contaminated even though millions of dollars have been invested in clean rooms with the goal of making that impossible. Of course, this does not answer why the space probes that are sent to asteroids and comets have detected (using on-board sensors at a distance) complex organic molecules, and minerals that only form in liquid water, thus ruling out contamination.
- 2. God created comets and asteroids during the creation week with evidence of life (including bacteria) on them. This would include creating these objects in space in a near perfect vacuum and near absolute zero temperature with the building blocks of all life and had abundant liquid salt water at some time in the past.

3. Dr. Brown was right when decades ago, based on all the volumes of research he poured into determining the origin of these heavenly bodies was right when he concluded their origins were best explained by, "In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains [of water, not magma] of the great deep were broken up, and the windows of heaven [into and some back from space] were opened. And the rain was on the earth forty days and forty nights." Gen 7:11-12.

At the same time that scientific evidence is piling up in support of HPT, the Nature article deals an apparent death blow to PT/CPT. The secular authors admit that their past interpretation of low resolution seismic data, supposedly proving that cold ocean crust was subducting into the mantle, must now be called into question. The major proponents of CPT are not willing to even answer the question, 'Do you agree with the science and conclusions of this article, i.e. that anomalies in seismic tomography data cannot accurately be interpreted as subducting plates?'

Dr. Clarey did posit that the Nature article problem can be solved by understanding that the ocean plates subducted at meters per second. As stated earlier, this response does not at all refute the facts of the Nature article.

On March 1st, 2025 John did respond with the following comment to my first page of this document, partially repeated here, then followed by Dr. Baumgardner's thoughts with my response:

The authors of the Nature article all have a Plate Tectonic paradigm. Their discoveries using a more accurate method of seismic tomography to map the inner earth were surprising to them, causing them to question the validity of interpreting certain seismic anomalies near trenches as proof of subducting plates. Their revelation was in finding the same kind of anomalies in areas of the mantle that were thousands of miles from plate boundaries. They concluded that since these anomalies could not be subducting plates, the previous interpretations of the same anomalies near plate boundaries should now be questioned.

John Baumgardner: I'm not sure this is an honest interpretation of their paper. Their Figure 1 shows what they refer to as the "IBM (Izu-Bonin-Marianas) <u>slab</u>" in the western Pacific as well as the "Nazca <u>slab</u>" beneath the west cost of South America. They give no hint that they do not interpret these "slabs" as subducting plates.

Kevin comment: That is because the Nature article says that they no longer can interpret the data as subducting plates. On page three, the first paragraph, the Nature article states,

"These results suggest that not all positive wave speed anomalies in the lower mantle are thermal anomalies resulting from slabs that subducted in the last 200 Ma, and that they therefore do not represent a reliable proxy to reconstruct past subduction nor to directly constrain the thermal and density structure of the mantle."

Moreover, the prominent high seismic speed feature they show below the Java Trench is precisely along the seismically active subduction zone there.

Kevin comment: Dr. Baumgardner is again refusing to accept the conclusions of the Nature scientists. They no longer say that these density changes (speed changes) can be accurately interpreted as subduction zones.

The main anomalies which they emphasize in their paper are what they refer to as the "W Pacific Anomaly" and the "E Pacific Anomaly." They speculate that these heretofore unidentified anomalies may be correspond to a delaminated layer from the "base of the lithosphere" that has sunk "into the mantle as a result of gravitational instability" or be "chemical heterogeneities... from the segregation of the high-density oceanic crust (basalt) from subducted and/or delaminated oceanic lithosphere, particularly in the mantle transition zone." These seem to me to be viable possibilities.]

Kevin comment: But these possibilities do not support CPT and are the desperate guessing made by scientists that don't have a clue as to why they are seeing what they have just learned. Only HPT explains.
